PUBLIC HEARING: FY 2007-08 MEASURE A EXPENDITURE PLAN REQUESTS – Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District; Cities of Citrus Heights, Elk Grove, Galt, Isleton and Sacramento

Action Requested: Open public hearing, receive staff reports, continue public hearing

Recommendation

Open the public hearing, and take testimony on the FY 2007-08 Measure A Expenditure Plan requests for the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District, and the Cities of Citrus Heights, Elk Grove, Galt, Isleton, and Sacramento. Continue public hearing for the City of Rancho Cordova, City of Folsom, County of Sacramento, Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT), and Paratransit, Inc. Continue public hearing to June 14, 2007.

Discussion

Title II of the Sacramento Transportation Authority Code sets forth an annual process for the introduction, public hearing, and adoption of Measure A Expenditure Plans. For FY 2007-08, this process began in November 2006, with staff's submittal of a revenue estimate to the Measure A entities. The entities then submitted their requests for specific allocations that are being transmitted to your Board with your agenda packets. ***(PLEASE INSERT THE ATTACHMENTS INTO YOUR WHITE 2007-08 EXPENDITURE PLAN BINDERS, AND BRING THEM TO THE MEETING)***. Introduction of these requests is the first step in the public hearing process, which will culminate in adoption of FY 2007-08 Measure A Expenditure Plans on June 14, 2007.

Today, we open the public hearing, and take testimony on the expenditure requests for the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District, and the Cities of Citrus Heights, Elk Grove, Galt, Isleton, and Sacramento. We also continue the public hearing from April 12, 2007 for the City of Rancho Cordova, City of Folsom, County of Sacramento, Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT), and Paratransit, Inc.

Each of the Expenditure Plan requests has been adopted by the respective entity's governing board. In addition to the public noticing performed for each STA Board meeting, the adopted schedule for all of the FY 2007-08 Expenditure Plan public hearings has been published in two local newspapers of general circulation. It has also been published on the STA's web site. These efforts, along with live and delayed broadcast of the public hearings via Sacramento MetroCable, facilitate public exposure and help maximize the opportunity for public input.
