**INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATION ON NEW MEASURE A CAPITAL PROJECT:  
FOLSOM BRIDGE CROSSING**

**Action Requested:** Receive and file

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**Recommendation**

Receive and file an informational presentation on the City of Folsom's project to construct a new bridge across the American River.

**Discussion**

Today, we continue an occasional series of informational presentations on **New Measure A** capital projects. City of Folsom Public Works staff will provide an overview of the on-going project to construct a third automobile crossing of the American River, just downstream from Folsom Dam. This project became necessary when the federal Bureau of Reclamation closed the roadway atop the dam in February 2002 for homeland security reasons. The closure has resulted in the re-routing of hundreds of cars through Folsom's downtown business district each day. The new 4-lane bridge facility will accommodate both intra-city and sub-regional traffic. Approximately, \$37.6 million is earmarked for this project from **New Measure A** bond anticipation note (BAN) proceeds. The majority of project funding is derived from federal sources.
