CONTRACT EXTENSION FOR FREEWAY SERVICE PATROL BEATS 1 AND 2

Action Requested: Approve contract extension

Recommendation

Authorize the Executive Director to execute the attached contract amendment extending the contract for one year.

Discussion

In October 2006, the STA entered into Contract #06-FSP-01 with Sierra Hart Auto Center for the provision of motorist assistance services on Sacramento Metropolitan Freeway Service Patrol Beat 1 (Highway 99/Business 80 between Grant Line Road and Exposition Blvd.) and Beat 2 (Business 80/I-80 between Exposition Blvd. and Riverside Blvd.) for the period of December 1, 2006 to November 30, 2009. The terms of the contract provide for "a 1-year extension based on satisfactory performance of the contract services."

The California Highway Patrol's FSP field supervisors and STA staff agree that Sierra Hart's performance on the contract has been excellent. We therefore recommend your Board authorize the Executive Director to execute the attached contract amendment extending the period of performance for one year to November 30, 2010.

Staff has received a letter from College Oak Towing asking that the extension not be granted and that Beats 1 and 2 be put out for bid this Fall. As the incumbent contractor has met all terms of the contract, we do not find a valid reason not to grant the extension. If your Board approves the extension, these Beats will be put out for bid in Fall 2010.
