**INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATION ON MEASURE A CAPITAL PROJECT:
CAPITAL SOUTHEAST CONNECTOR**

Action Requested: Receive and file

Recommendation

Receive and file a status report on the Capital Southeast Connector Authority's on-going effort to design, finance, and construct a new multimodal expressway connecting Elk Grove, Rancho Cordova, and Folsom in the southern and eastern portions of Sacramento County.

Discussion

Today, we continue an occasional series of status reports on Measure A capital projects. Capital Southeast Connector Authority (CSCA) staff will provide an overview of current administrative, planning, and environmental activities that will ultimately lead to construction of a new multimodal expressway linking the Cities of Elk Grove, Rancho Cordova, and Folsom and the western portion of El Dorado County. This new facility will accommodate travel among these housing and employment centers, and will help reduce congestion on State Route 99 and US 50.

Approximately \$118 million is earmarked for this project in the Measure A Capital Allocation Plan, with approximately half of that total scheduled for allocation after 2030. Ten million dollars of Measure A funds has been expended to date, with another \$25 million expected to be available during the next three years for early construction activity.
