**A RESOLUTION SETTING AN
APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-18**

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Transportation Authority has previously set an Appropriations Limit of \$245,944,139 for Fiscal Year 2016-17; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1 of Article XIII B of the California Constitution, the Appropriations Limit is to be adjusted annually for changes in local population and changes in statewide cost of living or per capita personal income (price factor); and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Finance has determined that the Sacramento County population change rate and the statewide per capita income change rate used to calculate the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Appropriations Limit are 1.20% and 3.69%, respectively.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sacramento Transportation Authority's Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year 2017-18 is **\$258,079,711**, calculated by adjusting the FY 2016-17 limit of \$245,944,139 by the appropriate factors as follows:

$$\$245,944,139 \times 1.0120 \times 1.0369 = \mathbf{\$258,079,711}$$
