SUBJECT: SB1 Local Partnership Program (LPP), Formula Allocation Project Candidate (Green Valley Road Widening Project)

Dear Susan:

The City of Folsom hereby submits the Green Valley Road Widening Project as the agency's proposed project for the Senate Bill 1 (SB1) Local Partnership Program (LPP), formula funding allocation. The City of Folsom shall be the implementing agency for these funds, and the Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA) shall be the applying agency.

The Green Valley Road Widening Project involves the improvement of Green Valley Road between Blue Ravine Road in Folsom and Sophia Parkway in El Dorado County from an existing two-lane rural road to a four-lane arterial with improved shoulders and a safety median. Green Valley Road carries over 22,000 vehicles per day as part of an important network of regional arterials that carry traffic around Folsom Lake, serving the counties of El Dorado, Placer and Sacramento.

The project cost is \$4.1M, and is funded in large part (\$3M) through the Regional/Local Funding Program of the Sacramento Area Council of Governments. The SB1 formula allocation will be matched by developer impact fees. Pursuant to Section 100.16 of the Streets and Highways Code, reversible lanes were considered but were not deemed feasible.

We appreciate the opportunity to help rebuild and improve California through the use of these gas tax funds, and we are confident that the taxpayers will consider this a worthy candidate for the use of their tax dollars.
