BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On November 8, 2018, the STA Governing Board selected a consultant team headed by Townsend|Calkin|Tapio Public Affairs to conduct public education, community outreach, opinion research and expenditure plan development for a potential November 2020 supplemental transportation funding ballot measure. The contract was executed November 9, 2018.

Over the next several months, the local Measure A entities will present their unmet transportation needs to the Board, tentatively according to the following schedule:

- Paratransit, Inc.
- Sacramento Regional Transit District

The transportation expenditure plan development process is planned to begin in September and continue into October, November and December.
