

## WHAT IS MEASURE A?

The Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA) was created in 1988 upon the passage of "Measure A" by Sacramento County voters. Measure A initiated a twenty-year transportation improvement plan for Sacramento County, funded through the levy of a one-half percent sales tax. The STA is the local government body created to oversee the collection and distribution of the sales tax in accordance with the twenty-year transportation expenditure plan. Measure A entities include:

- County of Sacramento
- City of Sacramento
- City of Citrus Heights
- City of Elk Grove
- City of Folsom
- City of Isleton
- City of Galt
- Sacramento Regional Transit District
- Paratransit, Inc.
- Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District

Using the Measure A Countywide Transportation Expenditure Plan (CTEP) as a strategic guide, the Governing Board of the STA adopts annual expenditure plans and enters into contracts with these entities for the design and construction of specific projects.
