



Select Accomplishments: International Bridge



Provides alternative capacity to busiest arterial in region and route with upgraded bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

Measure A Total - \$2.6 M
Total Value - \$13.8 M

Select Accomplishments:Folsom Streetscape Phases 1, 2 and 3




Connects Transit, businesses, schools and neighborhoods with rehabilitated roads, bike/ped improvements, transit connections and beautification.

3.3 miles improved.

Project Delivered 2012 Measure A - \$4.7 M Total Project - \$24.5 M

Select Accomplishments: Zinfandel Bike and Pedestrian Signals



Completed important 5 mile neighborhood loop.
Connects transit, businesses, schools and neighborhoods.
Encourages alternative modes of transportation.

Project Delivered 2018 Measure A - \$78,000 Total Project - \$737,000

<u>Under Construction and Coming Soon</u> Folsom Streetscape Project Phases 4 and 5



Connects Transit, businesses, schools and neighborhoods with rehabilitated roads, bike/ped improvements, transit connections and beautification. 1 mile improved.

Measure A - \$6 M Total Project - \$15 M






Challenges – Deferred Maintenance




- Average PCI = 69
- **Deferred pavement maintenance = \$63 M**
- Need \$112 M over 10 years to reach PCI 80 and reduce deferred pvmt. maint. to \$27 M
- Additional \$30 M in required sidewalk improvements
- \$90 M shortfall over next 10 years

Challenges – Critical Connections \$170 M



Challenges – White Rock Road Existing Conditions



Measure A

 2004 Measure A invested \$32.6 million to leverage \$125 million in City and region.

Current critical challenges \$260 million plus.
